What is the Intervention & Referral Services (I&RS)?

I&RS is a school based team that provides assistance to teachers and parents of students experiencing learning or behavioral difficulties in regular education classes.

Who is involved?

The members are: Social Worker; Kathy Lee, Teacher; Melissa Hall, Teacher; Colleen Lee, BSI Instructor; Maryann Nicosia, and Superintendent Debbie Snyder. The classroom teacher and the student's parents are also vital members of the team.

How does it work?

Teachers who have concerns about a student will make a request to the I&RS team for assistance. The teacher will notify you, the parent, that he/she has a concern and is requesting a I&RS meeting. The teacher will also provide you more detailed information about the reason for the request for assistance. You will be notified of the meeting and encouraged to attend. The group will converse, problem solve, and brainstorm some strategies to help your child be more successful. These strategies will be implemented for a certain amount of time and then a follow-up meeting will be held to evaluate the effectiveness of the strategies.
