Dear Parent or Guardian:

Based on your child's English proficiency test scores, level of academic achievement, and/or teacher recommendation, your child is eligible to participate in our district's English Language Learner (ELL) program for students who need English language instruction. The goal of the program is to help your child learn English and meet age-appropriate academic standards. On the elementary school level, students normally participate in the ELL program for a period of one to four years. Your child will be given thirty minutes of instruction daily in a small group setting and/or in a push-in program provided in the classroom. Strategies and techniques used in ELL are planned to meet the individual needs of students. Some include individual instruction, cooperative learning, and the use of technology.

Your child's level of proficiency in English was measured using the WIDA-ACCESS Placement test.
